TEST DRIVE

Lateral Transfer 2017 Toyota Corolla iM

hough the Scion brand was disbanded last year, the freshest parts survived. Three models migrated to the Toyota lineup for 2017, including the two-seat sporty car 86 (nee FR-S), four-door sedan Yaris iA and this week's test car, the Corolla iM.



The iM fleshes out the Toyota compact series by adding a cool looking, five-door hatchback to go along with the perennially popular Corolla fourdoor sedan. Hatchbacks — strangely overlooked by American buyers for years— have found a niche in the compact ranks, providing a sporty

foil to the traditional, sedan body style. Corolla iM is offered in one, well-equipped trim level. My test car this time had the one major option (a Continuously Variable

Transmission, \$740), and an as-tested price of \$20,750.

The front-wheel-drive Corolla iM pairs Toyota's 1.8L four-cylinder engine with either a six-speed manual transmission or available CVT, and I've driven both combinations. By EPA's reckoning, there's little to choose between the two when it comes to mileage. Fuel economy is estimated at 27 city/35 highway/30 combined (manual); 28/36/31 (auto). Looking at a handful of comparable hatchbacks, the Corolla iM's mileage is

better than the Ford Focus, Mazda3, or VW Golf, and trails the Honda Civic.

At 137 horsepower (@6,100 rpm) and 126 lb.-ft. of torque (@4,000 rpm), with a 0-60 time of between 9-10 seconds, the Corolla's power output is outpaced by the competition mentioned above. In normal, 'round town driving, it's a non-issue, as the car rolls away smartly from a stop. But tion to my rule.
